SCHOOL STATEMENT

As in line with Trafford LEA Guidelines, Well Green Primary School is a no smoking environment. It does not allow smoking in any part of the building. Smoking is also not allowed on any part of the school premises.

This policy has been shared with the staff and governors. All staff, parents and children are aware that both the school buildings and premises are 'smoke free' environments.

No smoking signs are clearly displayed around the school premises – in the ladies and gents' toilets, staffroom and entrance hall. Smoking cessation leaflets are freely available to parents, staff and pupils, and are available in the entrance hall or office.
