# The school day

- Book bags to be placed into trolley and water bottles on the trolley please. Children will come in to the classroom alone and hang up their own coats on pegs.

# Equipment

- PE kit in drawstring bag with shorts, t shirt, trainers and socks
- Spare clothes

- School book bag (no school bag needed)
- Coat every day (with a hood and ideally shower proof!)

# Snack and Lunch

- School meals provided for all children
- Snack- fruit/ vegetables and snack provided in school. £10 school fund voluntary contribution
- Water only in water bottle please

# Important information

- Medical conditions- please make sure we are aware
- Inhalers to be named and brought into school to stay here
- All medication to be given to adults in school (not in children's book bags)
- Dietary requirements and allergies needed for snacks and lunches

# Preparing to start school

- Independence in toileting and hand washing
- Putting on own coats and shoes/ wellington boots
- Being able to dress and undress themselves
- Recognise their own name
- Develop their ability to take turns and share toys with friends
- Begin to help tidy their own toys away
- Follow simple two step instructions

# The school day

- Daily phonics using Floppy Phonic scheme
- Daily Maths carpet sessions. Implementing Mastering Number programme to support early number skills
- Supervised snack times
- Daily play indoor and outdoor to work on physical development and motor skills
- Daily story time and singing

# Early Reading

- Reading for pleasure at home with your child daily
- They will begin to bring home reading scheme books in the autumn term and we will have a further meeting to support you with the phonics teaching and development of early reading skills
