Dear parents/ carers,

As the holiday season approaches, we at Well Green Primary School hope that you and your families enjoy a peaceful, warm and restful break. While this time often brings joy, we know it can also bring stress, financial pressure or emotional challenges. Please remember that it's OK to ask for help, you don't have to face difficulties alone. Looking after your and your children's mental and emotional wellbeing is important.

If at any point over the holidays you or your child need support, here are some services you can reach out to:

Mental Health & Wellbeing Support

- Shout — free, anonymous, 24/7 text-based support for anyone in crisis. Text 85258.
- Kooth — free, safe, and confidential online mental-health and wellbeing support for children and young people across the UK.
- TOG Mind — local mental-health support for adults and families in Trafford (for parents/carers who may need emotional support).
- Place2Be's Parenting Smart Site

Domestic Violence & Abuse Support

If you are experiencing domestic violence or abuse, help is available. For urgent 24/7 support, call the free national helpline Refuge Domestic Abuse Helpline on 0808 2000 247.

You can also contact local services via Trafford Domestic Abuse Service for help, advice or safety planning.

Food Banks & Practical Support in Trafford

If you are facing financial hardship or struggling to provide enough food, there are local food-bank services available in Trafford, which can provide emergency food parcels:

- Trafford North Foodbank — based at The Leathwaite Centre, 227–229 Winchester Road, Stretford, M32 9PT. Phone: 0161 243 0720.
- Trafford South Foodbank — serving the Altrincham, Hale, and surrounding areas. Phone: 07749 378 447.
- If you need help accessing vouchers or additional support, Citizens Advice Trafford can be contacted on 0808 278 7803 for referrals to food bank services or other support.
- Other practical support may be available via Trafford Assist (household essentials, debt/benefit advice, energy bills etc.).

Once school reopens, I will be available in school every Friday and you are very welcome to come and speak with me. It doesn't have to be a formal appointment, sometimes even a simple chat can make a difference.
